

Draka Cableteq USA Steps Up to Cable Management Challenge

Stone and Webster, a division of the Shaw Group, based in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is in the business of engineering, procuring and constructing (EPC) large industrial and utility facilities. Conduit size limitations, combined with storage capacity restrictions at the Sun Oil Company Marcus Hook facility, dictated that Stone and Webster needed a supplier to both meet specific requirements as well as take on a demanding cable management role – a role which no other cable manufacturer was willing to respond to based upon the initial requirements.

Because Draka Cableteq USA (DC USA) is a manufacturer of cable products and does not normally perform distributor functions such as cable management, this request presented somewhat of a challenge. One that DC USA undertook in order to meet the customer's needs.

DC USA assembled the cable at one of its facilities, then transferred the cable to another of its facilities to multiplex large MCM sizes of cable. The result - Just in time shipping to the customer's job site within 72 hours from time of cable release.

The dedicated engineering and manufacturing teams worked tirelessly to provide the perfect solution for this customer.
